Thank you for expressing interest in the Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated Omicron Gamma Omega Chapter Scholarship. Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. is the oldest Greek-letter organization established by African-American college-educated women. The sorority serves the community through a nucleus of more than 170,000 women in over 900 chapters across the country and internationally. The Omicron Gamma Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. services the Glen Burnie area and other surrounding communities in Anne Arundel County. For over 25 years, the chapter has made it a priority to be involved in perpetuating the ideals of the organization and to provide "service to all mankind." In 1983, the chapter presented its first two scholarship awards. Since then, more than \$50,000 has been awarded to deserving high school seniors in the area.

An applicant for the 2009-2010 Omicron Gamma Omega Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority Scholarship must be a high school senior who has (1) a minimum grade point average of 3.00, (2) resides in Anne Arundel County, (3) attends Anne Arundel County schools or was an Omicron Gamma Omega Little Miss Ivy contestant, and (4) plans to attend a college/university in the following fall semester. Former Little Miss Ivy Contestants may apply provided that they have a minimum grade point average of 3.00 and plan to attend a college/university in the following fall semester.

Please complete the attached application and include the following:

- A one page (double-spaced) essay describing your higher educational goals and career plans for the future;
- An official high school transcript;
- A wallet sized picture of yourself (to be used in publication); and
- Two letters of recommendations. They may be from high school teachers, counselors and/or administrators.

The application must be postmarked by Friday, February 26, 2010. Upon review of your application, the committee will notify applicants regarding a place and time for an interview. If selected, the interviews are scheduled for Saturday, March 20, 2010 and Sunday March 21, 2010.
